The winery's reserve-level Pinot spends 18 months in 50% new French oak. The fruit leans toward black cherry, with a slightly roasted quality. The aging in new barrels adds a warm smooth mocha flavor, and the acidity closes with a touch of citrus. – PG



Wine Spirits

This smells exceedingly savory, with a sarsaparilla spiciness and a scent of red flower petals, but in flavor, this dark pinot is a clean shot of red fruit. The sanguine feel of the tannins pretty much begs for a charcuterie plate. – PC
